

URGENT PRESS RELEASE APRIL 29th 2004
JOSEPH SCHOLES INQUEST – JURY WILL DELIVER VERDICT ON
FRIDAY

The coroner in the inquest into the death of Joseph Scholes will begin his summing up of the evidence this afternoon and the jury will begin considering their verdict on FRIDAY morning.

The jury will also be asked to identify failings relating to the circumstances of Joseph's death. The coroner has also indicated that he will be making recommendations that will go some way to preventing similar deaths in the future.

The inquest, which began hearing evidence on the Monday 19th April 2004, is sitting with HM Coroner for Mid and North Shropshire J.P Ellerey.

The family of Joseph Scholes and INQUEST will be making a statement at the conclusion of the inquest.
