Roger Sylvester's Family to Hold Public Meeting

On the night of Monday 11th January 1999, Roger Sylvester, a thirty year old black man, was restrained outside his home by eight police officers from Tottenham Police Station. Seven days later Roger was dead.

His family waited almost five years for Roger's inquest to take place and were vindicated in October 2003 when the jury returned an unlawful killing verdict.

The police officers now seek to quash the verdict using public funds.

There will be a public meeting held on Sunday 18th April to discuss the latest developments.
