GARETH MYATT INQUEST ADJOURNED FOR HIGH COURT HEARING

The inquest into the restraint- related death of 15 year old Gareth Myatt has been adjourned due to a judicial review hearing in the High Court.

The hearing will be taking place at 10am on 14 May in the High Court of the Royal Courts of Justice, the Strand, London, WC2A 2LL. There will be reporting restrictions on this hearing as the inquest has been adjourned part heard.

The inquest will re-open for the coroner's summing up on 25 June at Rushden and Diamond Conference Centre, Irthlingborough, Northamptonshire, NN9 5QF.

The family is represented by INQUEST Lawyers Group members Patrick O'Connor QC of Doughty Street Chambers, Dexter Dias and Brenda Campbell from Garden Court Chambers and Mark Scott from Bhatt Murphy solicitors.
